Situated on a promontory overlooking the sea, the Grand Cairn de Barnenez is an unusual megalithic site.

Thought to be the oldest "mausoleum" in Europe, it was erected almost 6,000 years ago during the Neolithic era, a recent Prehistoric period corresponding to the emergence of agriculture, domesticated animals and the first houses. Revealing a perfect mastery of dry stone building techniques, it comprises eleven passage tombs which break up its gigantic facade.

DID YOU KNOW...?

Some of its tombs contain mysterious engraved messages that are still not understood!




